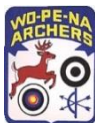




**NEW JERSEY STATE FIELD ARCHERY ASSOCIATION

DIRECTIONS TO BUCKSHORN SPORTSMEN CLUB

From Route #295:

Take Rt. #49 East continue to Mile Marker #13 turn right onto Jericho Road. When you are on Jericho Road go 5.1 miles to Hell Neck Road. Turn right onto Hell Neck Road then travel approx. 0.6 miles and turn left at the clubs sign (this will turn into a dirt road) follow this road to the club house. Use GPS location of 205 Hell Neck Road, Salem, NJ 08079.

DIRECTIONS TO WOPENA ARCHERY

From Northern NJ and New York State:

Take Garden State Parkway South to Exit 157 which merges onto Route 46 West towards Clinton. Stay straight and go onto Route 21 South. Take Exit 14 and bear right onto Lexington Ave. Turn right onto Clifton Ave. Turn right onto Main Ave. and then turn right onto Harding Ave. The Archery club is on the right side of the street.

FROM NEW JERSEY (WEST OF PATERSON & CLIFTON AREA)

Take Route 46 east and cross over the Garden State Parkway. Proceed approx. ½ mile and bear right onto Piaget Avenue Exit (CR-628). Turn right onto Main Ave. Make left onto Harding Ave. The Archery club is on the right side of the street.

FROM NEW JERSEY (SOUTH OF PATERSON & CLIFTON AREA)

Take the Garden State Parkway North to Exit 154. Proceed onto Route 46 East for approx. ½ mile and bear right onto the Piaget Avenue Exit (CR-628) Turn right onto Main Avenue. Make left onto Harding Ave. The archery club is on the right side of the street

FROM NEW YORK CITY OR GEORGE WASHINGTON BRIDGE:

Cross over the bridge and keep right to I-95 South (NJ Turnpike South) to I-80 West and the Garden State Parkway. Continue on I-80 West for approx. 6 miles. Take Exit 69 and quickly stay on the left to get onto the Garden State Parkway South. Proceed approx. 1.5 miles and make right onto Exit 157 which merges onto Route 46 West towards Clifton. Stay straight and go onto Route 21 South. Take Exit 14 and bear right onto Lexington Ave. Turn right onto Clifton Ave. Turn right onto Main Ave. and then turn right onto Harding Ave. The archery club is on the right side of street.

DIRECTIONS TO SPORTSMEN CENTER

FROM THE NORTH:

Take the I-287-S exit toward Perth Amboy, Take Exit 17 to merge onto US-202S/US206-S toward US-22 West Somerville/Flemington, slight right at US-206-S, At the traffic circle, Take the 3rd exit and stay on US-206, Turn right at US-206-S Stockton Street, Continue to follow US-206-S. Take the ramp onto I-95-N, Continue onto I-295-S, Take exit 57 for US-130-N toward Bordentown, Take exit 57-A toward US-130-N, Keep left at the fork and merge onto US-130-N, slight right on US-130-N, Destination will be on right.

FROM THE SOUTH:

Take the Garden state Parkway North, Continue onto NJ-109-N, continue onto Garden State Parkway N, Continue onto US-9-N, continue onto Garden State Parkway N, Take exit 38-A to merge onto Atlantic City Espy W toward Camden/Philadelphia, Take Exit 28 to merge onto NJ-54 n/12th street toward Hammonton/Trenton, continue to follow NJ-54-N, turn right at Bellevue Ave., continue onto US-206 N/ Trenton Rd., continue to follow US-206-N, at traffic circle continue straight to stay on US-206 N, slight right on US-130-N, Destination will be on the right.

FROM THE EAST:

Take NJ-88 E, Turn left at Bridge Ave., continue onto Burnt Tavern Road exit, Turn right on NJ-70-E, turn left at NJ-34 N, At traffic circle, continue straight to stay on NJ-34 N, Merge onto I-95 W via the ramp to Trenton, take exit 5A to merge onto US-130 S/Robbinsville Rd. toward Bordentown, continue to follow US-130 S, Make a U-Turn at the Highbridge Rd/Old Highbridge Rd.

FROM THE WEST:

Take US-206S/S Broad Street, continue to follow US-206S, turn right on Butts Ave., slight right toward Crosswicks Street, Turn right at Crosswicks Street, take the 1st left onto US-130/US-206N Slight right at US-130N.

Rules For The State Indoor SFAA Championship

1. The round will be **The Double Vegas Round**. 3 spot or single spot, archer's choice
2. The signal spot will be scored 10 to 1 plus the x count.
3. The 3 spot target will be scored 10 to 6 only plus the x count.
4. The round will be 10 ends at 3 arrows per end at 20 yds. (**CUBS will be 10 yds**). There will be a ten minute break after the first round. (ten ends)
5. After the 10th round move your target from top to bottom or bottom to top.
6. The time limit for each end of 3 arrows will be 2.5 minutes.
7. **There will be open practice permitted the day of the shoot UP TO 15 MINUTES BEFORE SCHEDULE LINE TIME**. There will be 2 ends for practice when the round begins. There will be no practice ends before the second round begins.
8. In the event of equipment failure the archer will be allowed 15 minutes repair time without holding up the tournament. One practice end will be allowed after repair. The archer will be allowed to make up any arrows missed during the repair time after the final end
9. Witnessed bounce outs or arrows passing completely through the target will be reshot.
10. This is a one day shoot an archer can shoot both days but in a different division.
11. All styles of shooting recognized outdoor by the SFAA will be recognized indoors.
12. The flight system will be used as per the NFAA for awards.
13. All NFAA rules will apply to this championship shoot.
14. All shooters will be given a plaque for first place in any division if you wish a belt buckle you will have to purchase it for \$30.
15. **Please fill in the club you belong to in order for your placement in the state to be credited to your club for the club trophy from the Championship 1st, 2nd, 3rd place have so many points to counted to help your club win the trophy. This will include the indoor and outdoor championship.**
